COVID PROTOCOL

In addition to the Italian Orienteering Federation (FISO)'s covid protocol, pay attention to the following points:

- For health safety reasons, the organizing committee recommends each athlete to carry out their own SARS-COV 2 test within 48 hours prior to the start of the competition;
- Once arrived at the finish, all the athletes have to move away from the finish area;
- No public is allowed, including any family member of the athletes;
- Until the moment of departure and after their arrival, all the athletes must maintain the safety distances and must wear protective respiratory devices, better FFP2/KN95 face masks;
- During the entire event, gatherings and groups of athletes must be avoided. The organization will be prepared to supervise and to remember to keep the distance. Please follow the instructions of the volunteers and respect the other athletes.

The IOF Adviser or the Event Director have the authority to suspend the race and / or exclude people from the race if the infection protection requirements are not respected.

TIMING AND PUNCHING SYSTEMS

SportIdent punching and timing system is used, with Air + activated in all races, Finish station included. Classic SportIdent can also be used. SIACs (Air+) are not available for hire. The control point code at the control is printed only on the SI stations. The control stations will be equipped with a manual punch in case of malfunctions, it is mandatory to manually punch and to show your punches at the arrival download.

MAPS WITHDRAWAL

After the finish, each competitor MUST deposit their map in his club's box. Maps will be given back to the clubs managers after end of each race, after the commentator announcement.

AWARDS CEREMONY

The awards ceremony will be held for the **first 5 ranked** in the MW Elite classes, for the first 5 clubs teams (at the end of the relay race) and for the first M18 ranked of the middle race (Nicola Comarella memorial award).

There will be prizes for the podium of all the rest of the classes and them will be given at the Event Office after the closing of the ranking of their category. We ask you to avoid gatherings for, by waiting for your turn maintaining a safe distance.

FOOD AND DRINKS IN THE COMPETION AREAS

No food or drinks will be provided by the organizers after the competition. All athletes will have to bring their own water to drink after arrival. There will be a takeaway catering service nearby (coffee, sandwiches). At the Vallorch Refuge (3 km 46.063733, 12.387097) it will be possible to have lunch, seated outdoor.

PARKING

Parking areas for cars and minibuses are available near the finish zone (Bus de La Lum area 46.060402, 12.410528). Caravans must park in the Camper Area in the center of Cansiglio's plain (fee needed, 1.5 km from the arrival 46.067012, 12.402792) or at the Vallorch Refuge (free of charge, 3 km from the arrival 46.063733, 12.387097).

MAPS

Foresta del Cansiglio - Archeton, Valmenera omologation CO895. Updated in ISOM2017 - 5 m contour interval - 1:7.500 (for Open classes and MW50, MW55, MW60, MW65, MW70, MW75) - 1:10.000 for the rest of classes. Maps are laser printed on A4 size, blueback paper. Relay maps will be provided with their own plastic cover, Middle maps can be covered at the start.

GPS TRACKING

To the athletes in the following list will be provided of GPS tracking (see the list published on the website). The advice is to use a vest own by the athlete, who does not have the vest can require one. Both the vest and the GPS device will be provided in the Event Office.

In the relay the same GPS device from the first leg will be used also on the third leg. We ask to the competitor to handle the exchange on their own.

The GPS devices will be returned after the finish meanwhile the vest will be returned after the end of the relay race.

NUMBER BIBS

All number bibs will be given at the Club's accreditation, printed with the personal race number and departure time of each athlete. It is mandatory to wear it visibly without covering any part of it. Safety needles are available at the Event Office. The first number indicates the leg in the relay race. In case of changes it is important that each runner has the corresponding bib to his own leg.

- 1st Leg runner, numbers from 1001 to 1999;
- 2nd Leg runner, numbers from 2001 to 2999;
- 3rd Leg runner, numbers from 3001 to 3999.

MAXIMUM PERMITTED COMPETITION TIME

Withdrawal athletes MUST punch the Finish control (to turn off any SIAC) and MUST communicate their decision to the arrival judge. Maximum race time is 2 hours for both races. After 2 hours from the start of the last competitor, control point will be picked up.

TOILETS

Nearby the arrival zone the organization will provide chemical toilets.

TERRAIN

All the races will be held at traditional stony karst terrains. Terrain is hilly with many details. Runnability and visibility are very good. Particularly dangerous holes, mapped with the appropriate symbols (rock hole: **v**) will be fenced with white / red tape on the ground.

GUIDED ROUTES

MW12 classes (Saturday) and MW13 classes (Sunday) will have a guided route between 2 controls because of the lack of obvious guidelines, marked with white tape.

NOTES FROM THE COURSE SETTER

There are many fallen trees; the main ones are indicated with both a root symbol and a green bar. The zones are always passable. Green roots indicate the most obvious trees. Possible presence of snow in some points that does not hinder the running speed.

In the Middle event the difficulty level of the DIRECT category is equivalent to M14, in the Relay event it is equivalent to M16.

SICARD/SIAC NUMBER CHANGE

All Sportident number changes must be notified to the Event Office before the athlete starts. (the change is for free).

MEDICAL POINT / FIRST AID

It will be possible to get medical assistance at the arrival area or at a designated point in the wood (marked on the map with a red cross). We remind you that if you notice someone needing assistance, it is mandatory to stop your race and give your help.

EMBARGOED AREAS

CAMPING

Altipiano del Cansiglio is a natural reserve, it is not possible to camp for the night. The Italian Orienteering Federation doesn't allow the clubs to set up any tent in the competition areas.

WARM UP

A warm-up map will be available on Saturday 8 May with some control points nearby the event arena. The maps will be given in the club packs (1: 7500 - 1: 10000).

START

The middle race will have two different starts: the one for agonists will be 400 meters from the finish (P1) and one for non-competitive runners will be 1 km away from the finish (P2). Classes with start from P2 will have free punching start from 1.00pm to 3.30pm.

The start for the agonists (P1) is delayed (Swedish start), the K-control representing the triangle is 160 meters ahead of the map picking. At the gate -2 it will be possible to view the map preview indicating the position of the maps delivery, the triangle and the rescue point (it will be available in both scales: 1:7500 and 1:10000).

CONTROLS DESCRIPTION

It will be available at the start for the M Elite (13,5x5 cm) e W Elite (12,5x5cm); For the other classes it will be printed only in the map. It will be in text format for Beginners, MW10 and MW12.

RELAY TEAM CHANGES

Team modifications are allowed up to 8.00 pm on Saturday 8 May 2021, at the Event Office or via email to iscrizioni@ortarzo.it. In case of legs order list changes, runners will have to switch their bibs due to the first runner will run wearing the 1xxx bib, the second 2xxx and the third 3xxx.

MASS START

The mass start area is slightly separated from the finish, it can be reached following the southern path from the main road. Mass starts for the first leg are organized as follows:

- 1. 10.00 am: M Elite, W Elite
- 2. 10.10 am: M17, M20, M55, W65, WK
- 3. 10.20 am: M35, M45, M65, MK, W55
- 4. 10.30 am: M13, W13, W17, W20, W35, W45, OPEN

Second runners who have not received their change by 11.25 am will start with a mass start at 11.30 am.

Third runners who have not received their change by 12.25 am will start with a mass start at 12.30 am.

Relays teams starting the second or the third leg with a mass start will be ranked after the ones that switched regularly (IOF Rule 24.7).

START PROCEDURES

Competitors will reset/clear their SiCards and check them using the clear and check controls. These stations are located before the entrance to the departure / switch area.

- 1st runner: will enter the start / switch area and goes directly to his own map on the ground (bib number wrote on the back). After the punch of the last control point, he goes through the arrival corridor until he gives the change to his partner with a "fake touch" (avoiding touching himself but making it clear to whom he is switching the leg), he punches the finish, deposits the map, proceeds to the download at the exit.
- 2nd runner: after the first runner passes at the show point (the estimated time from passing to the show point at the last checkpoint is about 5-7 minutes) he enters the switch area clearing and checking his SiCard, takes his map rolled up and awaits the relay mate, who will switch with a "fake touch". Now he is allowed view the map and go to K-point (located 250m ahead) following the main road.
- 3rd runner: same procedure as the second runner. After the last control point, he runs through the finish corridor until he crosses the finish line, punches the finish, proceeds to download and to exit the finish area. In case of a sprint finish (head head), the competitor who first crosses the finish line will win, not the one who punches the finish first.

To avoid gatherings, a demonstration of the mass start and switch procedures will not be carried out.

INDIVIDUAL CLASSES START

Individual classes will start their competition at the special start point which is 600 meters away from the Event Arena, with punching start system from 10.30am to 12.00am.

CONTROLS DESCRIPTION

Controls descriptions will be printed only on the maps. Text format will be provided only for Beginners (ESO) and MW10 classes.
